Banking in Berrigan. The NAB have announced the closure of their Berrigan branch on July 7th 2017. The NAB are actively working towards the installation of an ATM—its location is currently uncertain. The Berrigan community has formed a steering committee that has been charged with the task of:

1. Establishment of a Bendigo Bank agency in Berrigan
2. Work towards the establishment of a community Berrigan Bendigo Bank.

Bendigo Bank representatives have visited Berrigan and are currently in the process of negotiation with two viable sites. We will announce the location once the commercial agreements have been signed between Bendigo Bank and the successful site.

Everyone should also be aware that Australia Post are able to offer basic banking services for many banks including NAB, ANZ etc.

If Berrigan is going to succeed with the establishment of its own Bendigo Berrigan Bank then we will need the support of every single person, organisations, businesses and farmers (agri-businesses) to move part or preferable all of their banking needs over to the Bendigo Bank. The Bendigo Bank have guaranteed to us that all accounts opened with them from roughly 20th May 2017 will be credited as being part of the Berrigan commitment that is required to establish a successful bank.
