Refund for recycling bottles gets the go-ahead in NSW

A 10c refund for eligible drink containers will be in place by July 2017 to help reduce litter across Australia. The refund is part of the NSW Government's new Container Deposit Scheme (CDS), which will make a major contribution to achieving one of the Premier's priorities of reducing litter by 40% by 2020.

The scheme includes:

- A 10c refund for anyone who returns an eligible container.
- Collection depots will range from large-scale depots through to standalone reverse vending machines and pop-up sites.
- Funding of the 10c refund as well as the associated handling and administration fees will be provided by beverage supplier.

The financial incentive will encourage people and to recycle their drink containers and help volunteers gain extra funds through recycling.

BERRIGAN RED CROSS

The Berrigan Red Cross branch is a very active organisation in our community. Volunteers are crucial to assist in raising funds to support the needs of people. The branch has assisted with providing materials to the Girls Day Out project, and supplied the Berrigan Children's Centre with spare clothing for emergency use, they send clothing away to other areas and support families in the event of a fire or natural disaster. The Berrigan branch also has requests for food parcels from families for emergency relief that is supported by parcels through Moira Food Share.

Saturday 21st May, a local member, Andrew Horne, will be the Guest Speaker at the Red Cross Zone 29 Conference in Jerilderie. He will be speaking about his overseas trip as a recipient of Red Cross's Persia Porta Scholarship. Sunday 22nd May, he will present the Red Cross Address at the Berrigan Red Cross Church Service to mark the 2016 World Red Cross Day in the Catholic Church at 10.30am. Everyone is welcome to attend.

The Red Cross Shop, located in Chanter St, raises the majority of funds for the Berrigan branch to ensure the Red Cross is able to continue to do their humanitarian work. The Berrigan Red Cross Shop is constantly looking for volunteers to help. This is a wonderful community asset & service that has been open since 1969. If you could spare an hour or two to help out please call in to the shop & give your details. Many hands make light work.

Donations for national appeals are taken at the shop, providing receipts as donations over \$2 are tax deductible.




MOSAIC ADDITIONS TO BERRIGAN
