## FIREWOOD SEASON

Firewood is available for collection from State Forests, but there are rules and regulations that must be followed.

In order to protect the forest environment, Forestry Corporation of NSW controls the amount of firewood collected and where it is collected from.

### Before collecting firewood from State Forests you must:

- Have a valid permit and have paid for the wood you want to collect.
- You may only take fallen timber.
- You may only collect firewood from the area shown on the map attached to your permit.

## B.A.D.S.

The Berrigan Amateur Drama Society was originally formed in 1923, by a local dentist, Garry Byrne, and featured DE McLeod in the starring role of their first play, 'Tom, Dick and Harry'. It was continued over the years featuring such local talent as Snow McLeod, Dorothy and Len Abbott, Gordon Allan and Laurie Shiels, among others. In the 1950's Lol and Alma Lynas played an integral part in the development of the club fostering much of the local talent and presenting musical review and productions such as 'The Ghost Train', 'Cuckoo in the Net', and 'Blithe Spirit'. As a tribute to Alma Lynas, the BADS (which had reformed in the late '60s) were reformed in the seventies with their first 3 act play in 1976—'Boeing-Boeing'. Many productions have followed since, using local talent and presenting a high standard of performance.
