Tokyo to San Francisco, one hundred and eighty days, eight hours of swimming a day, 5500 miles (8851kms) - this is The Longest Swim.

Tyral Dalitz, the son of Michael and Kathy Dalitz, is the research manager and watch leader, aboard the Discoverer, a 67ft steel hulled, fully equipped and 100% self-sufficient sailing boat. The Discoverer will be hosting Benoit Lecomte and his support crew, as Ben swims from Tokyo to San Francisco, breaking records, raising awareness and for research purposes.

A team of researchers from 13 scientific institutions including NASA and Woods Hole Oceanographic Institution will be conducting studies in eight different subjects during The Longest Swim. They will be studying the plastisphere, radiation from Fukushima, giant phytoplankton, high definition water data, microbiome, the gravity effect and affects on the body and mind.
