We choose suppliers that support small business and good value quality product. We generally purchase Australian brands where they exist, from Australian owned businesses.

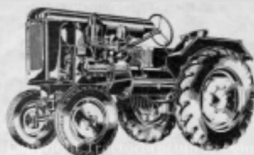
